- Increased need for mutual understanding, in which scholars play a crucial role



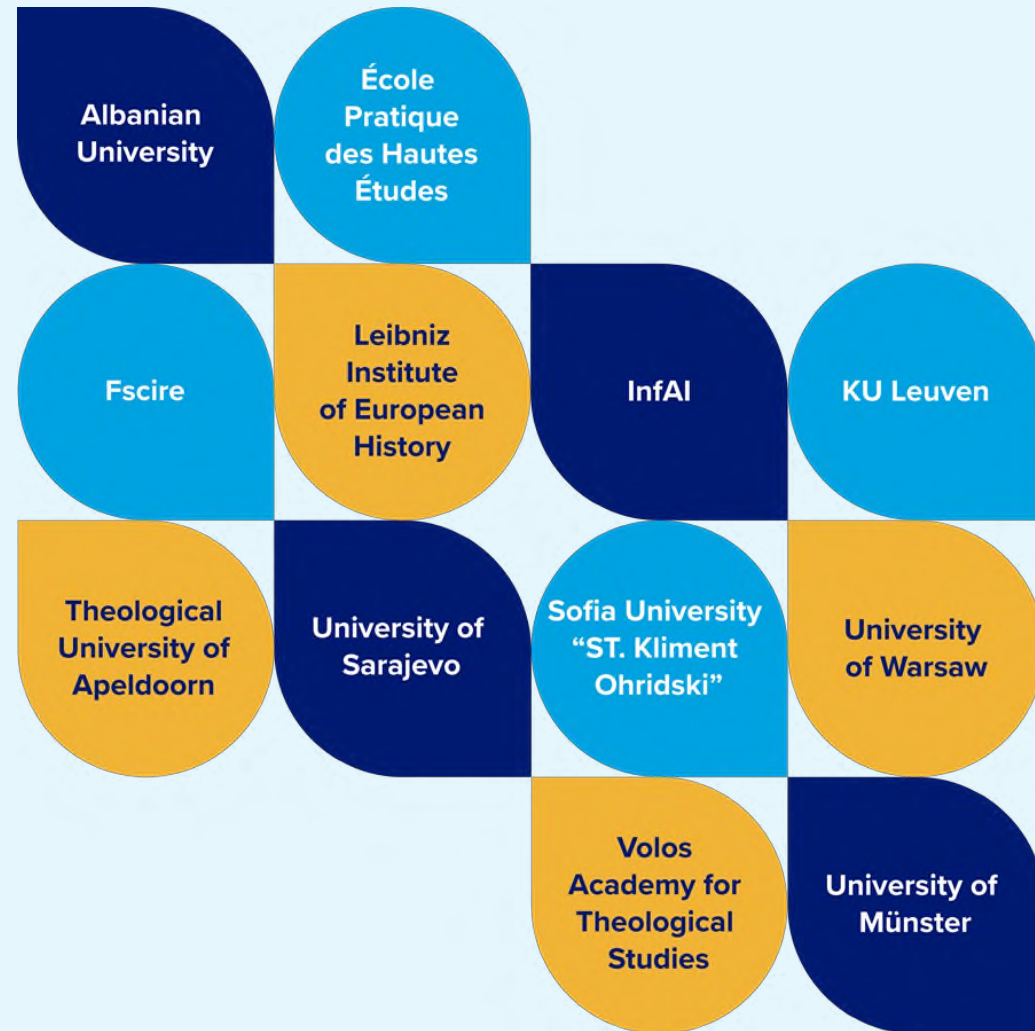

# How to become a TNA Host?

- TNA = Trans-National Access.
- TNA aims at providing access to physical data.
- No full membership (Member Country) is necessary.
- No extra fees.
- Memory institutions are GLAM institutions like Galleries, Libraries, Archives and Museums.

# How to become a TNA Host?

## Procedure:

- Contact RESILIENCE and send a catalogue of your resources.
- Sign an agreement with RESILIENCE.

# How to become a TNA Applicant?

- Contact RESILIENCE to be hosted with or without travel funds at a TNA Host to physically access its resources.
- If no funds are available, the TNA host provides guidance to funding sources.
- Some partners provide advanced fellowship programmes.

# How to become a Research Data Manager?

- Contact RESILIENCE to be added in the RDM mailing-list for proactive discussions and get provided the most recent documents.

# How to become a Content Provider?

- Submit an abstract about the data source to be made available through RESILIENCE.
- Selection based on:
  - Relevance of the data for RESILIENCE's mission.
  - Data quality.
  - Usage of FAIR use standards.
